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After the difficulties that the world has faced in recent years, there was a welcome sense of normality about 2022. This was certainly the case for Fanatec GT World Challenge Europe Powered by AWS. We have enjoyed a fantastic season of competitive racing, while the number of fans joining us at the track has reached new heights.

Nowhere was this more visible than at the TotalEnergies 24 Hours of Spa. For the first time since 2019 our marquee event welcomed a full complement of spectators, who were present for another thrilling edition of this great race. We were also able to reprise important off-track traditions, such as the parade and music concert, which further emphasised the return to a normality. Walking around the venue, there was a real sense that the event was back to its absolute best.

As well as spectators in the grandstands, we also saw excellent numbers on the circuit. The 24 Hours drew a superb entry list comprising 66 cars, a field that has been surpassed only once since 2001. The Endurance Cup and Sprint Cup grids were both around their ideal levels while the standard of drivers, both professional and amateur, remains extremely high. On this note, we were delighted to welcome Valentino Rossi to our paddock this season to begin the next chapter of his incredible career. Our racing activities rely on the support that we receive from our fantastic group of partners. We have once again drawn great benefit from our title sponsorship with Fanatec, with whom we continue to break new ground through the Fanatec Esports GT Pro Series. We are grateful to AWS for its considerable contribution as our global technology provider, while Rebellion does important work as official timekeeper and we can always rely on an excellent product from Pirelli.

I must also pay tribute to TotalEnergies, as 2022 marked the end of what has been an incredible partnership. This year's 24 Hours was the 16th and final year of its title sponsorship agreement, a period that has coincided with ever increasing standards at the event. We now look forward to the dawn of a new era, with CrowdStrike taking up the mantle for 2023 and beyond.

With the 2022 season complete, our attention turns to the future. Having navigated a difficult period, it is gratifying to see Fanatec GT World Challenge Europe Powered by AWS back to its very best. We are well placed to thrive in the years to come and, in closing, I wish to thank all of those who contribute to making this series such a success.

THE SERIES

In 2021 they were complemented by title sponsor Fanatec, while long-term partners TotalEnergies and Pirelli remain strongly

committed to the series. Alongside similar categories in Asia, America and Australia it forms part of the global Fanatec GT World Challenge powered by AWS, which allows manufacturers to measure the success of their customer racing programmes

In 2023 Fanatec GT World Challenge Europe Powered by AWS will remain true to the principles that have built its success over more than a decade.

There will 10 rounds at high-level circuits, split evenly between the Endurance Cup and Sprint Cup, with the Crowdstrike 24 Hours of Spa as the marquee event.

Combining an illustrious history with a modern approach to competition, Fanatec GT World Challenge Europe Powered by AWS stands at the forefront of international motor racing.

Reserved for cars conforming to GT3 regulations and using SRO Motorsports Group's globally recognised Balance of Performance (BOP) criteria, Fanatec GT World Challenge Europe Powered by AWS can trace its roots back to the creation of the Blancpain Endurance Series in 2011.

Staged over five rounds and with the iconic TotalEnergies 24 Hours of Spa as its marquee event, the long-distance championship placed equal emphasis on professional and amateur competitors while promoting high standards both on and off the circuit. It quickly attracted strong grids and was followed in 2014 by the addition of a Sprint Series for short-format races, as well as an overall title to recognise the most consistent performers across both disciplines.

In 2016 the series names were adjusted to the Blancpain GT Series Endurance Cup and Sprint Cup. The championship continued to grow, with increased grids and ever-greater standards of competition coming to the fore. This was emphasised by record numbers at the TotalEnergies 24 Hours of Spa, with 13 different brands contesting the 2018 event and an incredible 72-car entry list in 2019.

Ahead of the 2020 season Amazon Web Services (AWS) joined as title presenter and Rebellion Timepieces was named official timekeeper to the GT World Challenge.


Spa grid had a parent who previously competed in the race. By Sunday afternoon the number had grown to 16, as Brenton Grove contested the 2022 event alongside dad Stephen, the latter making his TotalEnergies 24 Hours of Spa debut.

The Sprint Cup saw six different brands represented by 16

teams, while 71 drivers took part in at least one event. Misano delivered the biggest entry list of the season, with a 27-car field taking the start.

Between both disciples, a total of 1_0371 laps were completed in 2022.

The only car to complete every lap of the Endurance Cup campaign was the #50 ROWE Racing BMW. Seven cars went the distance in the Sprint Cup: the #26 Saintéloc Junior Team Audi; the #32 Team WRT Audi; the #53 AF Corse Ferrari; the #93 Sky Tempesta Racing Mercedes-AMG; and the #87, #88 and #89 Akkodis ASP Mercedes-AMG entries.



Taking the fastest driver from each car, the top-29 in qualifying were covered by less than one second around the 7km Spa-Francorchamps circuit. The best time was set by Antonio Fuoco (#71 Iron Lynx Ferrari), who posted a



The gap between first and second at this year's

TotalEnergies 24 Hours was 30.040

seconds, the biggest winning margin since 2016. This was also the biggest gap seen in this season's Endurance Cup. The smallest came at the finale, where just 0.873s separated first from second at the flag.

At Spa, multiple Pro-Am champion Louis Machiels became the first and to date only driver to reach

50

participations in the Endurance Cup.

Christopher Haase made his 49th appearance at the season finale, so the German is on course to join Machiels on a half-century of races next term.

With 18 cars, the Silver Cup was the biggest

class on the grid at Hockenheim. This marked the first time since the Endurance Cup travelled to the Nürburgring in 2015 that Pro was not the biggest category. The trend continued for the season finale, which also saw Garage 59 gualify fourth overall with its #159 McLaren, achieving the best grid slot of the year for a Silver Cup runner.

Iron Dames became the first team to enter an all-female crew at

Spa since 1997, when the trio of Rafanelli/Surer/Duez won their class at the wheel of a BMW. The Iron Dames matched this achievement in the new Gold Cup category thanks to its fourdriver line-up of Sarah Bovy, Doriane Pin, Michelle Gatting and Rahel Frey.

Audi now stands alone as the most successful brand in Endurance Cup history. Saintéloc Racing's victory at Hockenheim

was the German margue's 10th,

making it the first to reach double figures. Porsche is second with nine wins thanks to Dinamic Motorsport's triumph in the season finale at Circuit de Barcelona-Catalunya.

The #30 Team WRT Audi was the dominant Silver runner in this season's Endurance Cup. The trio of Thomas Neubauer, Benji Goethe and Jean-Baptiste Simmenauer wrapped up the title with a race to spare and ultimately



finished 49 points clear of their

nearest rivals. This was comfortably biggest winning margin in this season's Endurance Cup.





In contrast, the overall Endurance Cup drivers'

title was won by just **WO** points. This is not the closest finish to a season, however: in both 2019 and 2016, the championship was won by a single point.

With a combined total of 10 wins in Fanatec


GT Sprint, Ferrari was the most successful brand across all classes this season. The Italian marque scored two overall victories, six in the Silver Cup and two more in Pro-Am. It was therefore the only brand to triumph in all three categories. Audi and McLaren each scored eight Sprint wins, while Mercedes-AMG earned four. Eight of this season's 10 Fanatec GT

Sprint races were won from pole. The exceptions were at Magny-Cours and Valencia, both of which saw the #32 Team WRT Audi win from P2. The latter will go down as one of the most dramatic races in series history, with Charles Weerts making up two spots on the final lap to snatch the win.

Team WRT ended its 13-year long relationship with Audi having earned three overall Endurance Cup drivers' titles, five teams' titles and eight race wins, including a pair of triumphs at the TotalEnergies 24 Hours of Spa. In the Sprint Cup, the partnership delivered

45 overall wins, nine overall teams' titles and six overall drivers' crowns.


NUMBER OF CARS PER ENDURANCE RACE



AVERAGE NUMBER OF CARS IN ENDURANCE CUP







The Fanatec GT World Challenge Powered by AWS Series has joined the fast-growing world of sim racing with the release of its first official game, **Assetto Corsa Competizione**, which has given players the opportunity to experience the unique thrill of high-speed GT3 competition.

Produced by Kunos Simulazioni and 505 Games, Assetto Corsa Competizione has set the standard in driving realism with the highest quality graphics and photo-realistic weather conditions.

From sprint races to endurance contests, players have be able to get behind the wheel of GT cars from all manufacturers represented in the Fanatec GT World Challenge Powered by AWS Series, with each reproduced to an outstanding level of detail.

They have also had the opportunity to compete in different moments of the iconic TotalEnergies 24 Hours of Spa, with a dynamic weather system recreating the famously unpredictable climate at the Ardennes track. Laser scan technology has ensured that every circuit and car was recreated with the highest level of precision, with the smallest details perfectly matching the real world, while multi-channel audio sampling of actual GT cars have placed players at trackside.
